

The book is colorful and nicely illustrated. The story leads young readers on a movement journey where they discover personal space, general space, pathways, levels, balance, shapes, weight transfer, loco motor skills, non-loco motor skills, creativity, and more. It's a complete movement education lesson in one short story. There is also a Teacher Edition of the book available that breaks the movement concepts into lesson ideas with movement and conceptual objectives included. The Teacher Edition is also colorfully illustrated. This is a wonderful book that all teachers should have, PE teachers and classroom teachers alike. Reading it to your students is a great way to combine literature and physical activity in your classroom. It is available in hardback and paperback versions.
